ADMISSION CRITERIA

To be eligible for consideration, each applicant must meet the admission criteria for both the Schulich School of Business and the Osgoode Hall Law School. Osgoode Hall admission criteria can be found in the Law School's calendar. A limited number of students in Schulich MBA 1 or the first year of the Osgoode Hall LLB program will be considered each year for admission into the second year of the MBA/LLB joint program.

Schulich admission criteria are the same as those for the Schulich MBA program with the following exceptions:

Academic Background

 an undergraduate degree from a recognized university with at least an A- average in the last two full years (or equivalent) of academic work

GMAT Score

 scores on the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) of no less than the 85th percentile

LSA1

 scores on the Law School Admission Test (LSAT) of no less than the 85th percentile

Work Experience

 while work experience is not a requirement for the MBA/LLB joint program, it is important to note that the average MBA student has three-four years' working experience

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must apply both to the Schulich School of Business and to Osgoode Hall Law School

FEE SCHEDULE

Fees must be paid as follows:

- Year 1 or 2 in Schulich
- Year 1 or 2 in Osgoode Hall
- Years 3 and 4 (current Osgoode Hall tuition)
- students may register for MBA courses in the Summer term, in which case tuition is paid to Schulich
